

The text-based logo generated with the `\overleaflogo` command has a region of clear space around it, and is designed to be used on its own, rather than in the middle of a paragraph. The `\overleaf` command doesn't have this clear space, and so **Overleaf** sits nicely in a paragraph!

We've created this using TeX Gyre Adventor as the font, as it's free and looks very close to the actual logotype. The `\overleaflogo` and `\overleaf` commands defined here use the **Œ** from the `academics` package, and hence they currently only work with X<sub>Ǝ</sub>LaTeX and LuaLaTeX!

And here's a little bonus: an Overleaf duck drawn with the amazing `tikzducks` package (v1.2) by Sam Carter!
